Parks in Eagle, Idaho







Eagle Island State Park

545 acres of outdoor opportunities! Great for families as it features a twisty waterslide that is a hit among children of all ages as well a sandy beach connected to a designated swimming area, a large grassy picnic area, a volleyball court and five miles of maintained trails for horseback riding, hiking, and dog walking. Additionally, there is a 9- and 18-hole disk golf course. In the summer, Zip Boise offers zipline courses and tours. While in the winter, a snow-tubing hill opens for all ages.

Warm concessions and seating available as well!








Reid W. Merrill Park

Merrill Park brings the community together with of events throughout the year. Two of the most popular events include Baldapaloza and Haunted Woods. The park features a playground, splash pad, basketball, and sand volleyball courts, as well as an open field perfect for picnicking and throwing the ball around. 




Stephen C Guerber Park

Located off Hill Road, Guerber Park offers fun opportunities for adults and children. It features a large, newly remodeled playground with bright colors and a childlike flare. In addition, there are basketball courts, a little league facility, open grassy space, paved walking paths, and two rentable shelters with tables and seating perfect for birthday parties, family gatherings or an outdoor picnic. In the summer visitors can cool off in the splash pad and enjoy an array of water activities, toys, sprinklers and most famously a large dump bucket.





Eagle Sports Complex Bike Park
